LIVE Arts Education 2010-2011**What is LIVE Arts Education?**

LIVE Arts Education is a dynamic art program **FREE** for students in grades 3 through 8 that supports Arts Education curriculum and will bring professional artists into the classroom for a LIVE experience. This program is free-of-charge for provincial schools and is supported by Saskatchewan Arts Board, Saskatchewan Ministry of Education, and Regina Catholic School Board.

How does it work?

Schools access the live broadcasts through the LIVE SatNet. The program consists of a 30min live session with a professional artist followed by a 1 hour hands-on session, facilitated by the on-site classroom teacher with on-line help from the artist via Adobe Connect or phone. The program closes with a second live 30min broadcast where the artist will share aspects of their personal practice and answer student generated questions. - Programs for Grades 3-5 will be offered on 8 different mornings throughout the school year. Teachers and students in grades 3-5 will tune in to a live broadcast on the LIVE Satellite Network from 9:30am-10am; work in their classroom between 10am-11am (with on-line help available from the artist) and a final live on-air session from 11am-11:30am.
- The Grade 6-8 program will be offered on 8 different afternoons throughout the school year. This program will run from 1:15pm-1:45pm; with one hour of classroom activity from 1:45-2:45 (with on-line help available from the artist) and a final live on-air session from 2:45-3:15pm.

Who are the guest artists?

This year's program features mixed media artist Heather Cline, master-drummer and dancer Joseph Ashong, professional musician Randy Morin, professional dancer Misty Wensel, professional visual artist Alex Romero, professional musician Jeff Morin and professional visual artist Anita Rocamora. How do I sign up?
